Outstanding candidates with experience to teach in any specialty within toxicology are encouraged to apply. Course topics include statistics/experimental design, ecotoxicology, microbiology, and risk assessment, among others. Teaching assistants may be assigned to assist instructors as needed, and will be supervised by the instructor.

RANK: Lecturer

SALARY: Commensurate with experience and qualifications. The salary is approximately \$6,500 per course (prorated for percent of time).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must have a doctoral degree or equivalent in Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, and/or Toxicology or a related field completed or expected by effective date, and must present strong evidence of teaching competence or potential for teaching.
