EXAMPLE #4: Postdoctoral Scholar—Paid Direct with UC Supplement

In this example, the postdoc's external salary was not sufficient to meet the required minimum for his years of experience, so his faculty mentor supplemented his salary with discretionary funds. Of the total compensation, 95% is coming from the external agency and 5% is coming from the UC fund, and the appointee is understood to be employed full-time (100% effort) for the outside agency. Accordingly, supplements may only be paid with appropriate fund sources. PPS will give a Warning error message that the sum of all appointments exceeds 100% but will not reject the entry. If possible, dues will be deducted from the appointee's paycheck. If the paycheck is not sufficient to cover the deduction, dues may be collected by the UAW directly from the appointee.

Appointment #10— The %Full and Dist% should reflect the portion of the appointee's total compensation which is provided by the outside agency. For a full-time appointee, appointment 10 and appointment 30 should add up to a %Full of 1.00. For a part-

time appointee, they should add up to the prorated percent.

EXAMPLE #4: Postdoctoral Scholar—Fellow with UC Supplement

In this example, the postdoc's fellowship only covers a portion of the salary she negotiated at the time of hire, so the hiring department is paying the other portion of her salary with discretionary funds. Of her total compensation, 80% is coming from the fellowship fund and 20% is coming from the department's supplement fund, and the appointee is understood to be employed full-time (100% effort) toward the project for which she received the fellowship. Accordingly, supplements may only be paid with appropriate fund sources. PPS will give a Warning error message that the sum of all appointments exceeds 100% but will not reject the entry.

Appointment #10— The %Full should reflect the portion of the appointee's total compensation which is provided by the fellowship. For a full-time appointee, appointment 10 and appointment 20 should add up to a %Full of 1.00. For a part-time

appointee, they should add up to the prorated percent.
