RE: Additional Compensation for Lectures and Similar Services

Dear Colleagues:

Academic Personnel Manual Section 666-18(a) states that honorarium amounts may be subject to negotiation in each case, but may not exceed an amount stipulated periodically by the Provost and Executive Vice President, Academic Affairs. Former Provost Walter Massey's February 1, 1995 letter established the last such levels for honoraria, which I hereby adjust to approximate the California Consumer Price Index. Effective immediately, you are authorized to approve honoraria up to \$1,500 per event under the provisions of APM-666, and to grant exceptions up to, but not exceeding, \$3,000 per event. State funds may not be used for such additional compensation (APM-666-22).

Please note that (1) when the lecture or similar service occurs under the sponsorship of a major Department of Energy Laboratory, the home campus must be notified of any additional compensation paid under this policy; and (2) this provision for additional compensation applies to faculty only, (as defined in APM-110-4(14)), and not to other academic and staff employees.
